



Requirements for Childcare Providers with New Mums London:

- Must have the right to work in the UK.
- Demonstrated genuine love for children.
- At least one recent childcare reference is required, and families may request additional references during the offer stage.
- Enhanced DBS check or willingness to apply for one.
- Preferably hold current Paediatric First Aid certification or the commitment to complete the course (offering a 10% discount through a partnership).
- Availability for additional working hours ranging from 3 to 25 hours per week, including weekdays and weekends.
- Maintaining professionalism at all times and prioritising children's safety are of utmost importance.

Guidelines:

- Agree to commit to the family for a period of 1 to 9 a months, to be arranged at the start of the role.
- Maintain consistent weekly working hours to ensure effective collaboration with the family.
- Promptly inform New Mums London of any changes in working hours.
